

How does this Program Operate?

As long as there is money in the program, the **Pets for U.S. Vets Program** will pay the adoption fee for any dog, cat, puppy, or kitten from the Washington Area Humane Society. The potential adopter must meet all of our adoption requirements and provide proof they are a U.S. Veteran. All other costs associated with being a responsible pet parent will be the responsibility of the new family.

How do I get started?

Visit our website to see our amazing dogs and cats up for adoption or stop by our facility during regular hours. Visit our dogs in the main kennel area, the small dog room, or puppy room, or stop upstairs and visit our cats and kittens. Then, check with staff who are more than willing and able to guide you through the adoption process; they will provide you with the forms you need to complete and inform you of any paperwork they may need.
